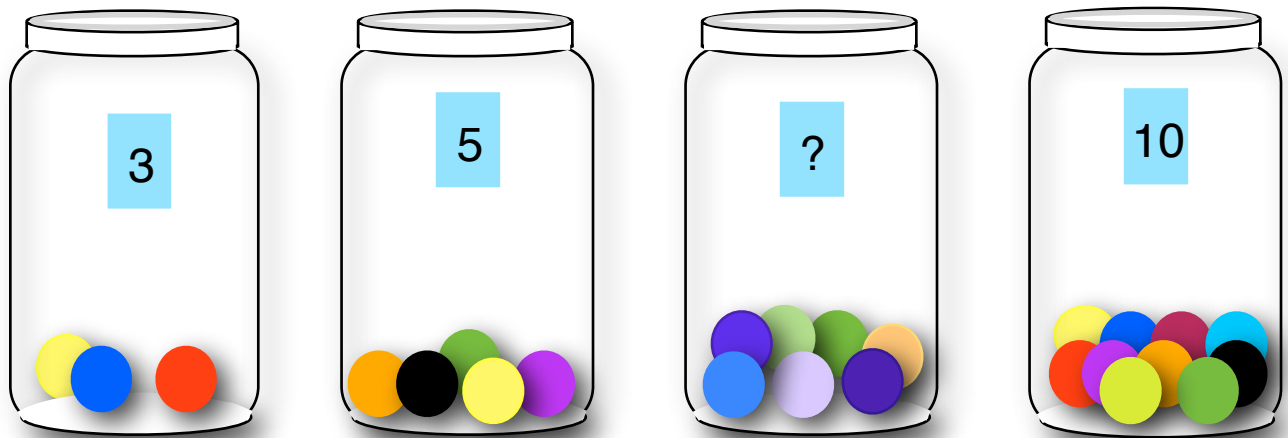


Estimation Station



When you estimate, you come up with an answer that is very close to the actual answer.

Goal:

Estimate the number of objects in a jar

You will need:

- Objects to place in the jars
- Labels for the number of objects in the jars
- A number line

What to do:

1. Look at the number of objects in each jar.
2. Organize the jars so the objects are in order from least to most.
3. Compare the number of objects to a number line.
4. Use the number line to decide how many objects are probably in the unmarked jar.
5. Count the objects.

Was your estimate close to the actual number?
