Mancala

Goal: To capture the most stones.

You will need:

Mancala board and 48 small stones

How to play:

- · Mancala is two-player game
- Sit across from your opponent with the board between you.
- The holes nearest you and the larger hole (mancala)
 on your right belong to you. The holes nearest your
 opponent and the larger hole (mancala) on their right belong to
 them.
- Begin by placing four stones in each of the twelve smaller holes.
- To play, pick up all the stones in one of your holes and distribute them, one at a time, into the holes, moving counterclockwise.
- Place a stone into your own mancala, but not into your opponent's mancala, assuming the stones get that far.
 - If the last stone placed lands in your mancala, you get another turn. Otherwise it is your opponent's turn.
 - If the last stone placed lands in an empty hole and the hole opposite contains stones, you may take these stones, plus your last stone, and place them in your mancala. Then it is your opponent's turn
- The game is over when one player is out of stones on their side of the playing board.
- At the end of the game, all remaining stones on the board are placed into the mancala on the corresponding side.
- The player with the most stones in their mancala is the winner.
