3 Little Firefighters


How will the 3 little firefighters find three matching sets of buttons? Find out how they sort it out!

Topics: sorting, counting

Math Connections: Use *3 Little Firefighters* to show that one group of objects can be sorted in different ways. Being able to sort objects by attributes (shape, size, color, etc.) is building a foundation for Algebra. When we collect like terms in an equation, we are sorting. When we make a bar graph, we are sorting the data into buckets. When you take a walk in the park or around your neighborhood, gather some natural items and play with your child to sort them in several different ways. See how creative you and your child can be.

Extension Questions:

1. How did the little firefighters end up solving their problem?
2. What are some of the ways the children tried sorting the buttons?
3. How would you solve the problem the children had: no matching buttons?


